Prepare for the State of Delaware Practical Nurse licensure exam (NCLEX-PN) in this intensive three semester program. Our program is designed to help individuals develop the knowledge, critical thinking, decision-making, technical and psychosocial skills, and caring required of Practical Nurses. Student nurses complete both classroom and clinical training during the full-time 11-month program.

This program is approved by the Delaware Board of Nursing, and is accredited by the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing, Inc., 3343 Peachtree Rd. NE, Suite 850, Atlanta, GA 30326 (404) 795-5000.

High school diploma or GED® and a favorable criminal background check required. Upon acceptance, applicants must initiate State of Delaware Adult and Child Abuse Registry check, and provide proof of health insurance or signed waiver, documentation of immunizations and a clean drug screen, and report of physical exam, including documentation of ability to meet physical requirements.

You must attend an information session, submit a completed application, provide two letters of professional reference, achieve satisfactory scores on the ATI Test of Essential Academic Skills (ATI TEAS), and interview with the Practical Nursing team.
