Hourly Wages

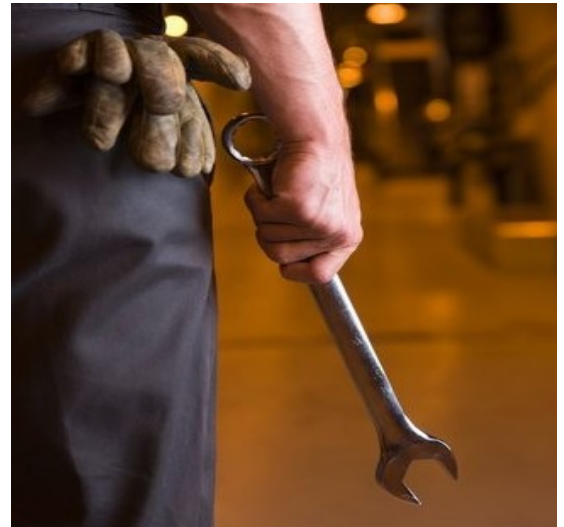
Entry Level - \$18.40
