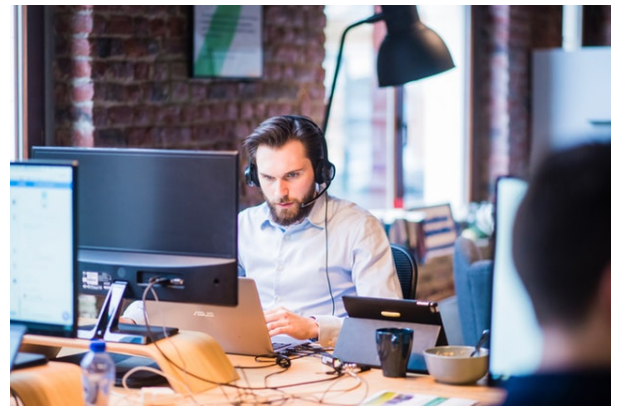

Cybersecurity Technician is a competency-based program that includes 288-hours of instruction delivered over two semesters. The program provides participants with the knowledge and technical skills required to protect computer networks and information.

Coursework focuses on practical problem-solving skills, required to assess the security of an organization, and the implementation of appropriate solutions. Topics covered include monitoring and securing hybrid environments, understanding applicable laws and policies, and identifying, analyzing, and responding to security events. Students are prepared to complete the CompTIA Network+ and Security+ certifications at the conclusion of the program.
